

Filter Maintenance

Weekly Maintenance:

Take filters out and rinse with water.

Monthly Maintenance:

Clean outer filters ONLY with Instant Cartridge Clean.

Directions:

1. Remove outer filter ONLY from spa and rinse thoroughly with water to remove loose material and/or large debris.
2. Saturate the filter with water.
3. Spray Instant Cartridge Clean over the entire surface area for maximum effect.
4. Let set for 5 minutes.
5. Rinse filter COMPLETELY with water and put back in spa.

***NOTE:** *Foaming may occur if not all solution is rinsed from filters.*

6. For heavily soiled filters, repeat steps 1 – 5.

3-6 Month Maintenance: (***Note:** *This maintenance is suggested when draining tub completely*)

Clean outer filters ONLY with Filter Clean

Directions: FOR BEST RESULTS SOAK OVERNIGHT and ALLOW TO DRY COMPLETELY

1. Remove filter(s) and rinse off any large debris.
2. Prepare Filter Clean solution by adding 16 ounces of Filter Clean to 4 gallons of water in a large plastic bucket or garbage can.

***NOTE:** *Do NOT use galvanized aluminum or porcelain container for soaking.*

***NOTE:** *Always add Filter Clean to water NOT water to Filter Clean.*

3. Place the filter(s) in Filter Clean solution and allow to soak for at least 3 hours.

***NOTE:** *Soak overnight for maximum effectiveness.*

***NOTE:** *One filter per container. Do NOT soak two filters in the same container.*

4. Remove the filter(s) and rinse thoroughly with water.

***NOTE:** *Foaming may occur if not all solution is rinsed from filters.*

5. If possible, allow cartridges to dry before reinstalling.

RECOMMENDATION

We recommend getting a spare set of outer filters to swap out when draining tub. This will not only prolong the life span of both sets of filters, but will not slow your time in refilling your spa.
